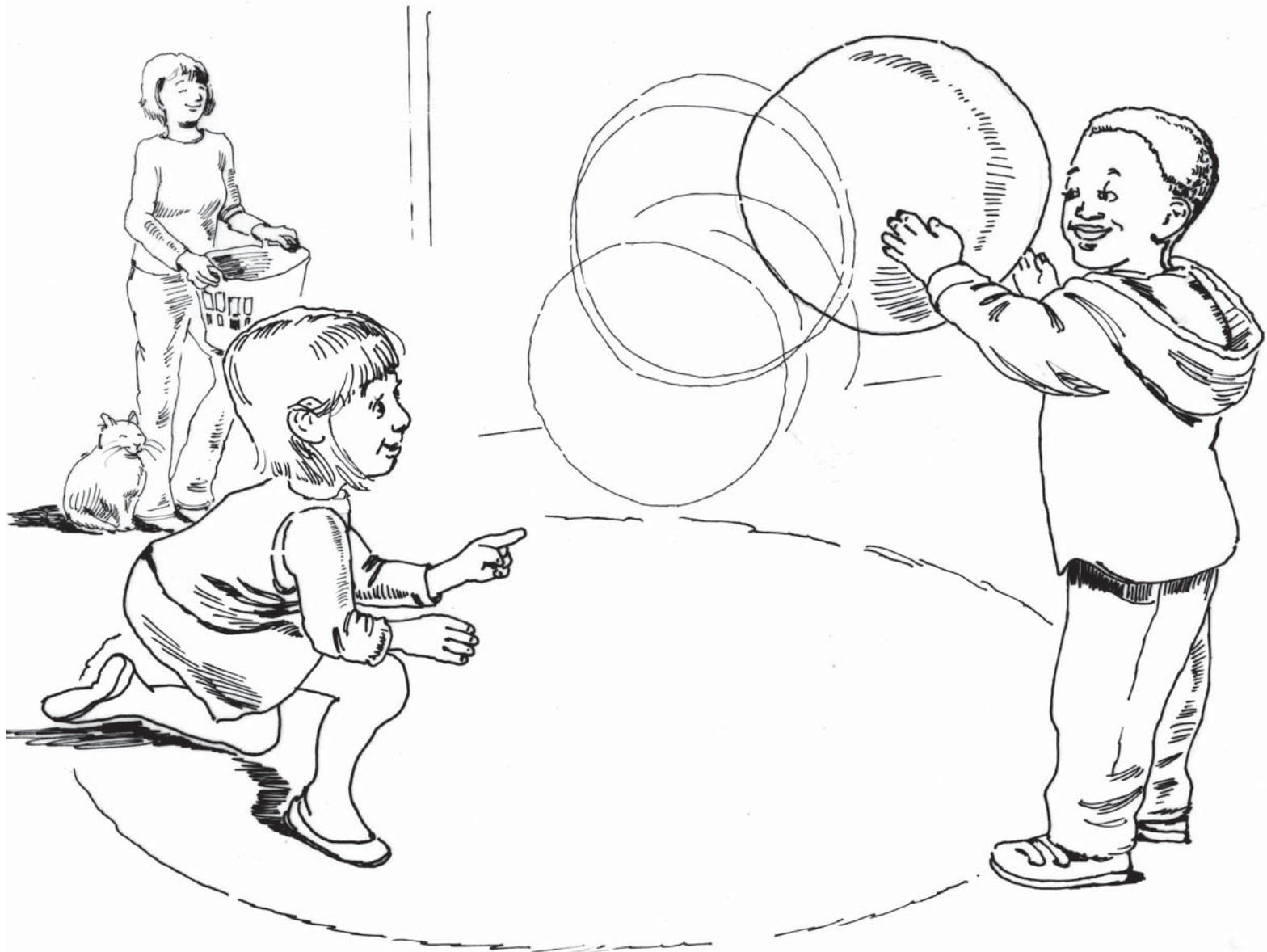
DeJuan came over to Maddie's house to play.

She bounced the **big ball**.



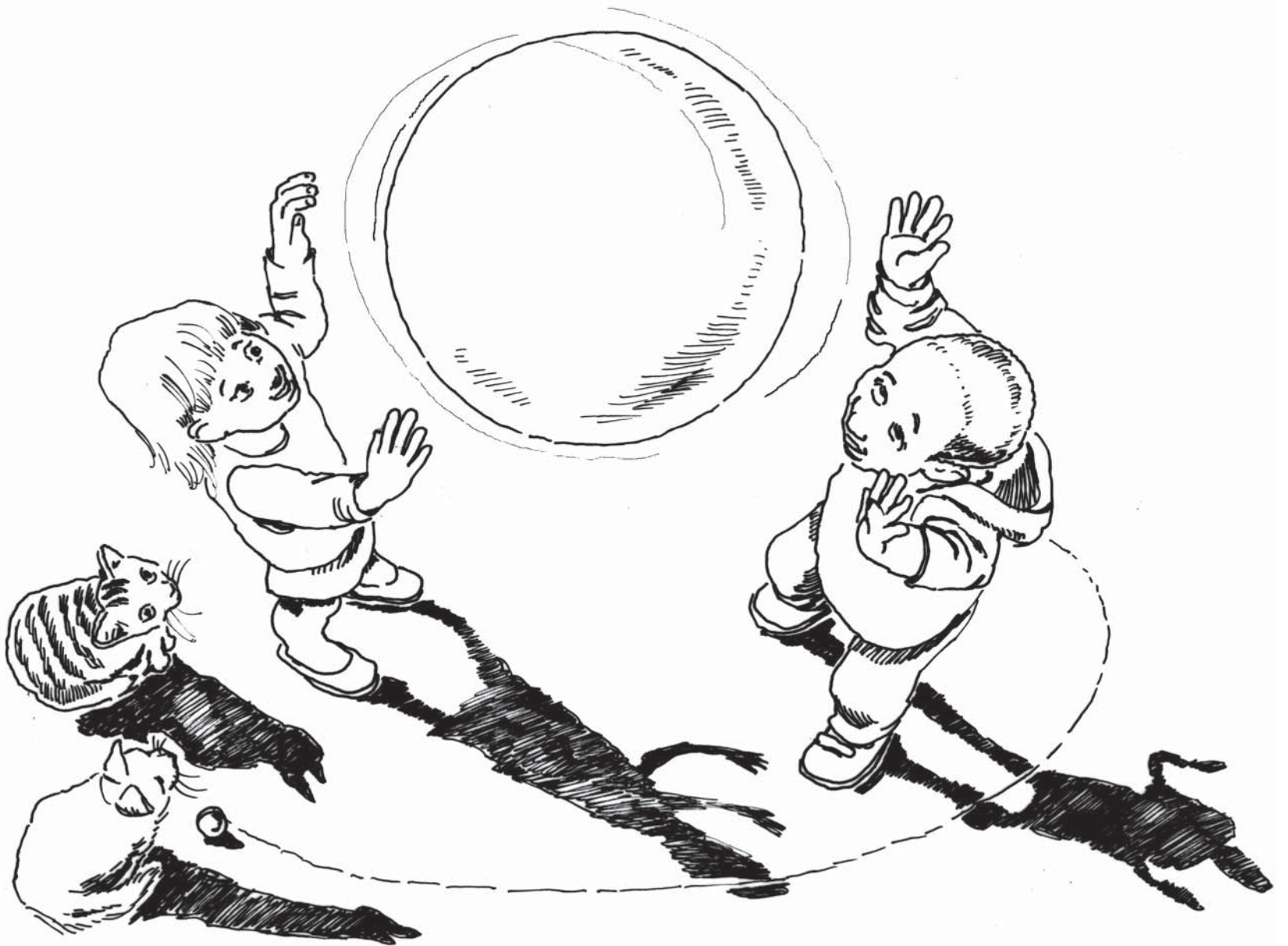
DeJuan wanted a turn.

She took another turn.



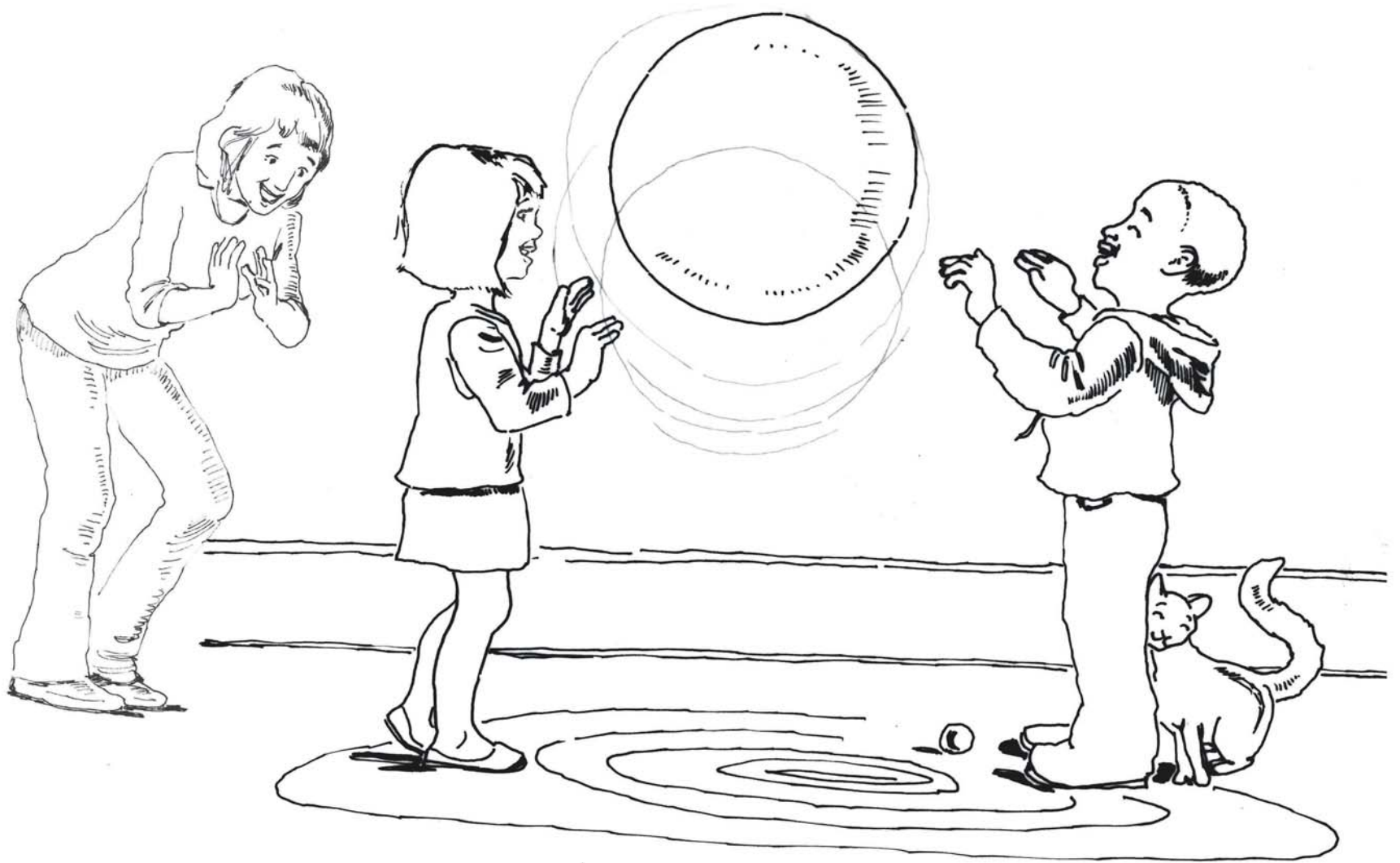
DeJuan tried to play ball, but Maddie said, "**NO!**"
